

SWEATER, PULLOVER

THIS SPECIFICATION AND ANY ACCOMPANYING SPECIFICATION OR BID CAN BE APPEALED.

YOUR APPEAL MUST BE SUBMITTED IN WRITING TO THE CITY PURCHASING DIRECTOR FOR ALL BIDS NO LATER THAN (5) FIVE WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO BID OPENING.

YOUR APPEAL MUST NOT ONLY IDENTIFY THE PROVISION, TERM OR CONDITION THAT IS CAUSING PROBLEMS, BUT ALSO YOUR PROPOSED ALTERNATE POSITION, TERM OR CONDITION AND BE SUPPORTED BY TECHNICAL DATA, TEST RESULTS AND OTHER INFORMATION.

- I. **GENERAL:** It is the intent of this specification to describe the minimum requirements for the Pullover Sweater to be purchased by the City of Milwaukee for the Police Department.

All items, details of construction, services or features not specifically mentioned which are regularly furnished in order to provide Pullover Sweaters shall be furnished at the bid price and shall conform in strength, quality and workmanship to that usually provided by the practice indicated in this specification.

II. DETAILED REQUIREMENTS:

A. FABRIC:

REQUIREMENTS FOR YARN:

TYPE: A blend of acrylic monstato pil-trol not to exceed 80% or less than 70%,
worsted wool not to exceed 30% or less than 20%.

CONTENT: Not less than 95% based on dry weight of sweater.

COUNT: Worsted 2 ply/11 1/4, times 2 ends

REQUIREMENTS FOR RE-ENFORCED PATCH FABRIC

CLOTH TYPE: 65% Polyester/ 35% Cotton - Twill Weave

WEIGHT: 8oz. Per square yard

COUNT WARP: 82 to 87 (+ or - 2)

COUNT FILL: 46 to 52 (+ or - 2)

TEARING STRENGTH (lbs.) - WARP: Minimum of 9 - FILL: Minimum of 0

MAXIMUM SHRINKAGE - WARP: Less than 2.5% - FILL: Less than 2%

REQUIREMENTS FOR TAPE RE-ENFORCEMENT

TYPE: Cotton woven tape, 5/8 inches wide conforming to Type II of DDD-T-86.

COLOR: Approximately the same color as the sweater.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THREAD

TYPE: Cotton, conforming to Type 1A3, ticket no. 40 and 50 of V-T-276.

B. COLOR:

Black

C. TYPE:

A 2 X 2 heavy rib knit Pullover "V" neck with turnback adjustable cuffs and with reinforced elbows and shoulders. Dacron / Cotton twill shoulder patches approximately 5" X 8" to extend from shoulder seam inward to edge of collar. Elbow patches also of Dacron / Cotton twill to extend from approximately 6" above sleeve end to elbow area, patches to be approximately 11" long and tapering from 5" to 4" wide.

Sweater shall have epaulets of matching twill 2" X 5" which permit the wearing of rank insignia, as well as a 2" X 4" nameplate holder placed over the right breast.

Sweater will include one regulation Milwaukee Police Department shoulder patch to be sewn on the upper left sleeve. One regulation "badge patch" shall be attached over the left breast, silver color for officers, sergeants and lieutenants, gold color for captains, deputy inspectors, inspectors, commanders, deputy chiefs, assistant chiefs and chief.

This garment is to be the same type and design that is authorized for use by the U.S. Army.

D. LABELS:

There shall be permanently affixed content and size labels.
