

ROOFER

(Milwaukee Public Schools)

PURPOSE: The MPS Roofer is responsible for preserving the integrity of roofs by installing, replacing, repairing, removing and maintaining built-up, membrane, shingle, slate, tile and other various types of roofs.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Locating and repairing leakage in various types of roofs
- Installing new roofing structures
- Removing, replacing, and repairing damaged roofs and flashings
- Developing an inspection and preventive roof maintenance program
- Estimating costs of time and materials for specific roof projects
- Setting up and working safely from bucket lifts and scaffolding
- Performing other job-related essential functions as assigned

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

1. Valid driver's license at time of appointment and throughout employment.
2. Availability of a properly insured personal automobile in which tools and equipment can be carried from job to job. Car allowance provided.
3. Certification in the EPA Asbestos Abatement Training Program within 6 months of appointment.
4. Residency in the City of Milwaukee within 6 months of appointment and throughout employment.

NOTE: Roofers must furnish their own hand tools.

DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS:

- Journey-level roofing experience
- High school diploma or equivalent (GED)

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES REQUIRED:

- Significant knowledge of the roofing profession with skills sufficient to perform the tasks typically performed at the journey level
- Skill in installing, removing, replacing, repairing and maintaining all types of roofs
- Ability to safely operate equipment used in the roofing profession including but not limited to tar kettles, sweepers and felt layers
- Knowledge of various kinds and sizes of roofing materials
- Knowledge of methods and strategies used to determine sources of leaks in various roofs and to repair leaks
- Knowledge of all equipment used in the craft (tar kettles, sweepers, felt layers, etc.)
- Skill in using the hand tools required in the roofing profession (spud bars, shingle and slate pry bars, knives, shovels, etc.)
- Ability to select the appropriate roofing materials for various projects
- Skill in calculating and estimating costs of time and materials for projects
- Ability to work safely from bucket lifts and scaffolding
- Skill in removing ice and snow from roofs in emergency conditions
- Ability to work safely with hot and dangerous materials, smoke, dust and blown aggregates
- Ability to climb and work at heights at or above 70 feet in all weather conditions
- Ability to move objects weighing 50 lbs. or more
