

# TIRE REPAIR WORKER I

The Tire Repair Worker I will be responsible for inspecting, repairing tires and tire tubes, evaluating tires for recapping and selecting the matches for proper rims and tires needed for city vehicles, and performing other closely related tire maintenance and tire repair duties as assigned. Tire Repair Workers are also responsible for changing tires in the shop and in the field in all weather conditions.

## ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Inspecting tires, tire tubes, and rims for damage
- Mounting and dismounting tires
- Repairing tires and tire tubes
- Selecting tire matches for proper rims
- Evaluating tires for recapping
- Inflating tires
- Providing tire-related road service to city vehicles
- Balancing tires
- Branding tires
- Snowing operations including road salting operations and snow emergency plowing

## MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

1. One year of experience mounting and repairing tires or performing other responsibilities closely related to the essential functions above.
2. Valid Driver's license at the time of appointment.
3. Commercial Driver's License (CDL) without Air Brakes restriction within six months of appointment.
4. Residency in the City of Milwaukee within 6 months of appointment and throughout employment.

## PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Certification in Tire Repair by the International Tire & Rubber Association (ITRA)

## REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES:

- Ability to inspect tires, tire tubes, and rims
- Ability to repair tires and tire tubes
- Ability to evaluate tires to determine need for recapping
- Ability to mount and dismount tires
- Ability to safely and properly inflate tires
- Ability to balance tires
- Ability to change tires in the shop and in the field
- Ability to operate job-related equipment
- Ability to safely and properly brand tires
- Ability to move or transfer objects weighing over 50 lbs unassisted

Note: Incumbent must be available for emergency duty during non-standard business hours.
